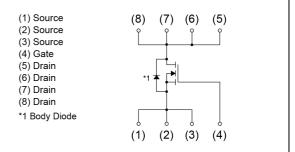

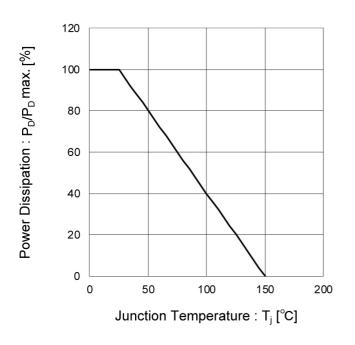


Fig.1 Power Dissipation Derating Curve

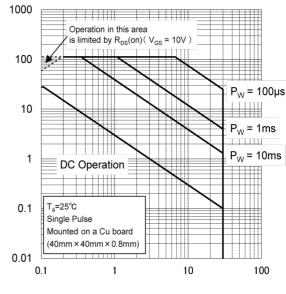
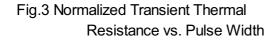
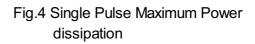
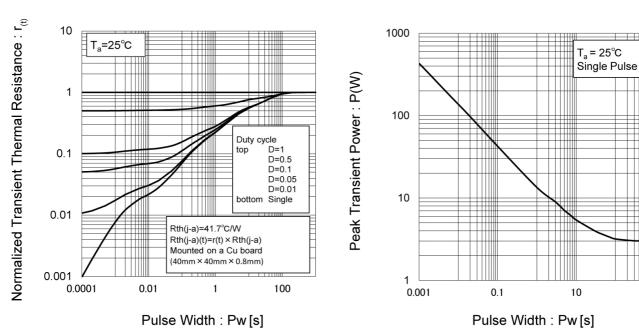


Fig.2 Maximum Safe Operating Area

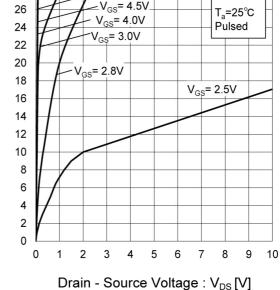
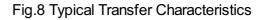


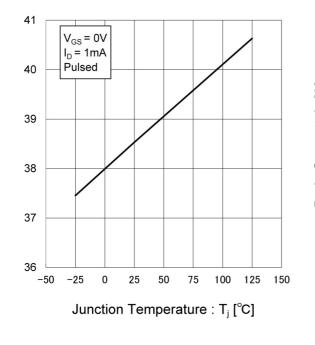
Fig.7 Breakdown Voltage vs. Junction Temperature

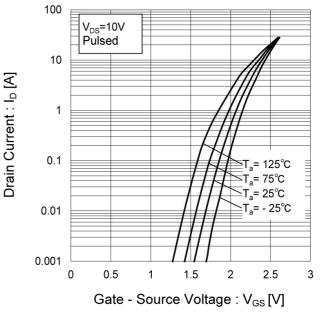

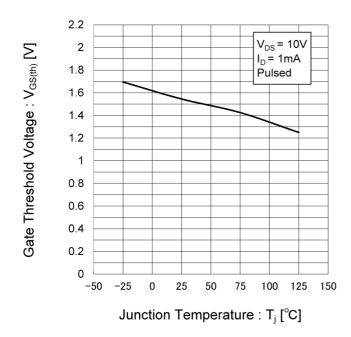




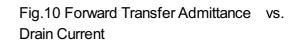

# Fig.9 Gate Threshold Voltage vs. Junction Temperature



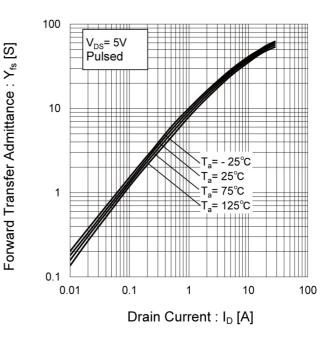
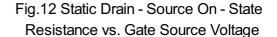
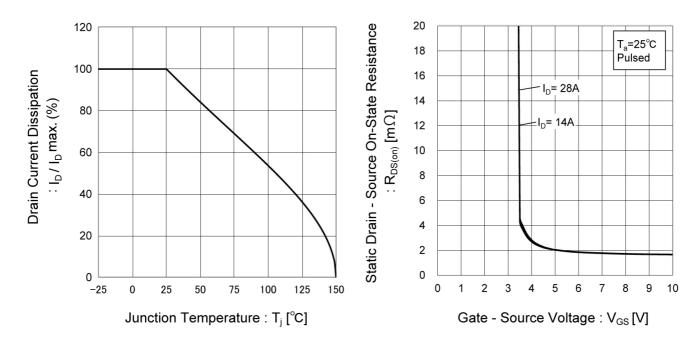


Fig.11 Drain Current Derating Curve

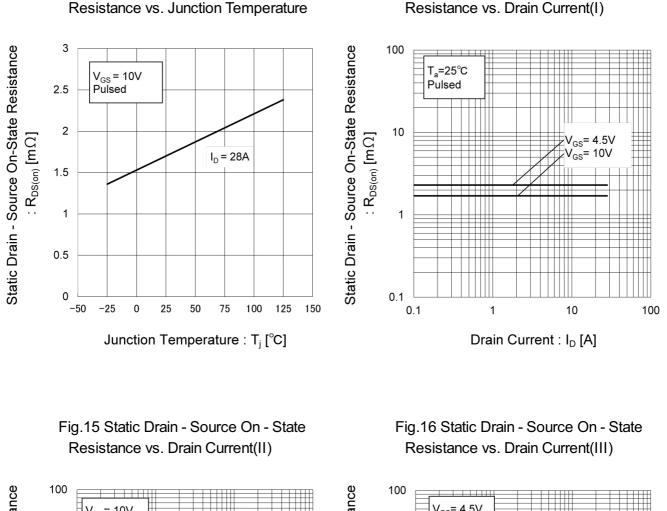

Fig.13 Static Drain - Source On - State



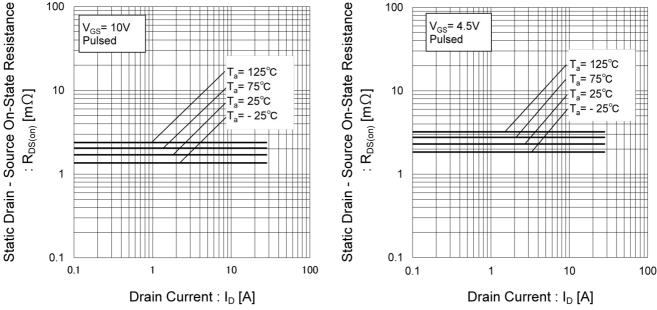
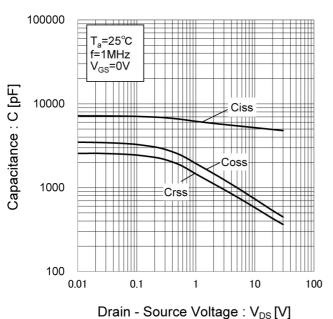


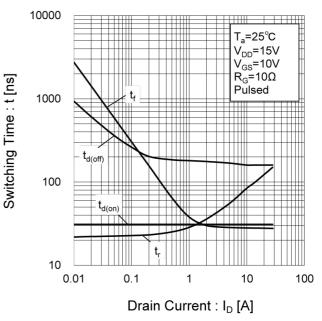
Fig.14 Static Drain - Source On - State Resistance vs. Drain Current(I)

Gate - Source Voltage : V<sub>GS</sub> [V]

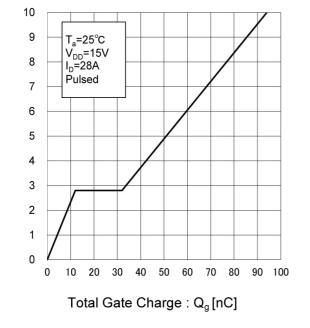
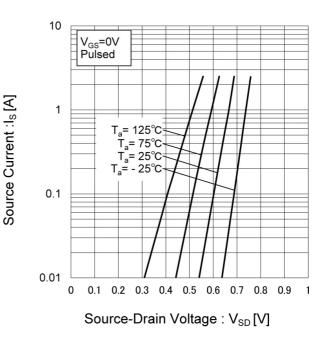
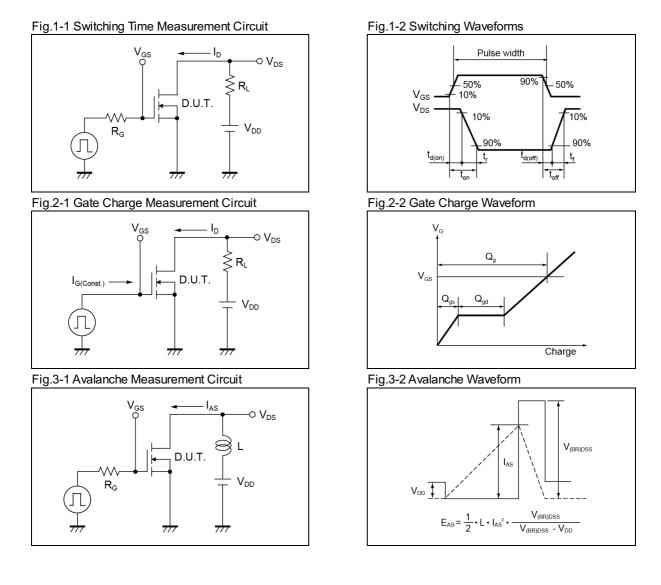


Fig.20 Source Current vs. Source Drain Voltage





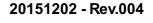

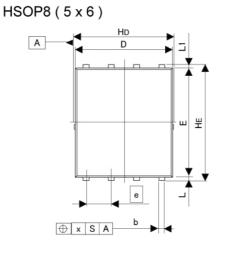

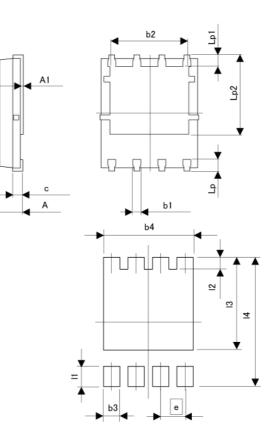
